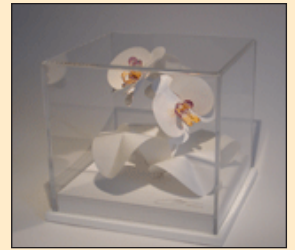

Much has happened since Ron sent his last update. We'll start with the fact that there is a new name for the newsletter. The name has been changed to reflect Ron's recently renamed work studio. Based on serendipitous events the studio has taken on a moniker to which it is well suited. The new name is, "*The Mill*."

Ron has often referred to the studio as the paper mill. The studio has fascinated many people including a great friend and collector who had the opportunity to see Ron work his magic. She took note of the pallets of paper, the tables and benches covered with tools, acrylic frames, sketches and drawings to work in all stages of the creative process. These include pieces still in their infancy expressed merely as flat sheets of paper to nearly completed works of fine art. She commented, "I love the energy here. It's like a creative factory." As you may know, "*The Factory*" was actually the name of Andy Warhol's studio. Ron responded, "I like to think of this as being more like a paper mill. We mill around, and some days I feel like I've been through the mill." From that encounter, "*The Mill*" was born.

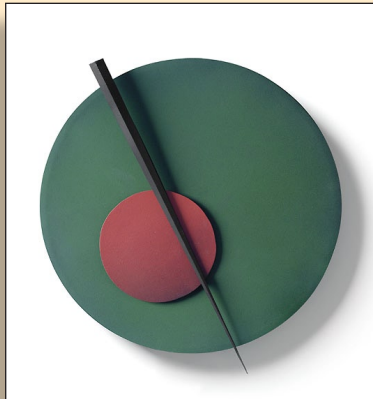

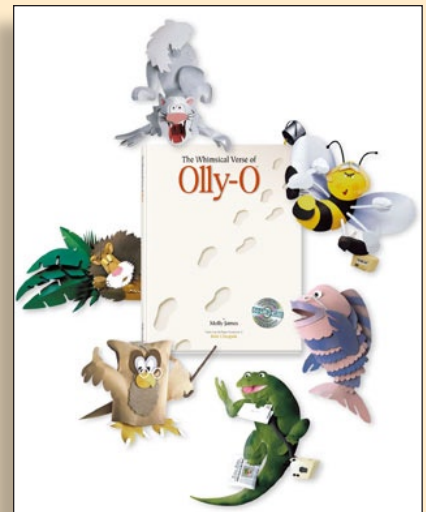
